

## Frisco Arts and Culture Council (FACC) Agenda August 16, 2024 at 12:00pm in Frisco Town Hall in Council Chambers Minutes

- Roll Call

- Approval of July 12, 2024, Meeting Minutes- approved with one correction- Tuesday is the preferred night for a restaurant crawl
- Frisco Voices Community Podcast: Phil Lindeman, Krystal Media News Director
  - o Examples- Brain Injury Alliance Colorado and Krystal 93: Jim Walsh
  - Phil- Krystal could handle interviews, equipment, some marketing, scheduling, and podcast hosting platform, and he would be open to offering youth learning opportunities in podcasts
  - \$1,000 per podcast with a possible goal of four in 2024 and six to 10 in future years and the Town would not need to provide equipment
  - Andy Held offered his video services free of charge
  - FACC would identify the community members to interview and what the topics would be
  - FACC would like to hear the stories of people who have made Frisco their home
  - FACC would be willing to pursue and would like an outline of how this would work
  - 45-30 minute podcasts at most and release each podcast in a strategic way
  - $\circ~$  FACC to come up with a list of three each and then decide who the first four will be
  - One-on-one interviews tend to be more understandable but certainly interviewing two at a time could be possible

  - Ask each interviewee who FACC should interview next
  - Goal- preserving Frisco voices and have a snapshot of Frisco and make sure it is entertaining
