- Sculpture Care Recap- Cleaning and waxing have happened, along with the restoration work. This fall the arrow at the bear sculpture, the ski pole on the skiers in Triangle Park, and elk still need welding/bronze work.
- RecPath Murals Recap- good feedback and people are visiting new areas of the rec path
- Tunnel Mural Update- Contractor has washed and treated and painting will start on September 23. It will take 9-12 days. Youth from Snowy Peaks and SOS are interested.
- Songwriting Workshop Update- Would like to use Jill Goods for this, and she will return in January so we will plan this in 2025.

Project Discussion

- Podcast- Please come prepared to continue discussion from August meeting
 - First season details: audio/video format, guests, title, outline from Andy Held and Daymon Pascual- Would like to start with some easier interviews for the first two or three podcasts and would like to have 3-4 in the can before launching. Daymon would like to entertain having someone other than Phil host the podcast. Todd would like this to be more than one person per episode. Ally would like it to be more educational. Some ideas for interviews- Dan Koski, Bobby Kato, Lynda Colety, etc... Have a local business highlight? Talking point-past, present, and future?

Podcast purpose: Entertaining with an element of education, expressing Frisco's unique culture, and recording past, present, and future

Podcast name: Suggestions- Frisco Bridges, Frisco Arts and Culture, Frisco Unfiltered, Uncultured in Frisco, Unfiltered in Frisco, Frisco Vibes, Frisco Connected

Podcast theme and questions: Building the Frisco community and culture and how the Town shaped you- past, present and future – for example a subject under this could be how Main Street became what it is, culinary scene, and developing Frisco/building buildings, and growing up in Frisco. Will start with these first four themes and ask the FACC for interviewees and questions for each theme. For the future- Latino culture in Frisco, music scene in Frisco, fashion in Frisco

Staff will send out a request for interviewees for the first four themes and possible questions.

- Frozen Frisco on January 25th, 2025- Same day as Eat, Ski, Be Merry. Group would like to do it with the ice company creating the scene for art and get more participation for commissioned art (maybe 4) and have some ice parts ready for people to create art. Have more string lighting above. \$12,000 to \$15,000 would be a plausible budget for this. FACC gave direction to staff to bring this back for the October meeting.
- Summer 2025 mural- begin discussion- pushed to the October meeting
