- Approval of September 20, 2024, Meeting Minutes- Approved
- Tunnel Mural Update- Pat Milbery thanked the FACC for the opportunity to do the tunnel mural and having Jamie Callahan’s support and guidance in optimizing the project design.   - Budget and Art Fund Update
  - Sound and Light Workshops Recap- Decent signup but not as strong as the spring signup. There were some ideas that came out of the workshop, including workshops on how to run a band rehearsal, how to advance a band including backline and reading contract, etc...
  - Elk sculpture move- There is an interest in looking at Zach’s Stop and Miner’s Creek Road. There is an interest in looking at placing it in the “woods”, maybe at the Dickey Day Use/Frisco Peninsula Parking Lot. There was discussion about not making it too accessible to people due to concerns about people climbing on the sculpture. The FACC believes the roundabout is not a great location due to safety concerns. The FACC believes that there are already enough bronze sculptures at Triangle Park.
- Project Discussion
  - Frozen Frisco on January 25, 2025
    - There is concern about participation, weather issues, and the cost around the “ice lounge”. Can we look at a company creating an ice globe or someone to create a snow lounge? FACC directed staff to reach out to new providers to see what is possible.
    - FACC would like to include more interactive components.
    - Finalize commissioned ice art details and budget- Would like staff to return with options before any decisions are made and to keep the budget to below \$12,000.
  - Podcast

- Finalize guests, questions, and podcast name for season one
  - Name- Between the Peaks
  - Purpose of the podcast: Entertaining with an element of education, expressing Frisco's and neighboring community's unique mountain culture, and recording past, present, and future.
  - Target audience: Core audience: former and current Frisco and neighboring community residents and peripheral audience: anyone with an interest in or relationship to Frisco and mountain communities
  - Direction to podcast guests: We want you to do some entertaining storytelling around mountain culture and how your time here has shaped you, and how you have impacted this community and how you want to impact it in the future.
  - Format: Episodes will be thematic, with guests and questions hand-selected by FACC members. For example- The Frisco's Culinary Scene episode will have 2-3 restaurant owners and/or workers doing one-on-one interviews with Phil that are then edited together to create a single episode guided by the overarching theme and purpose. Season one episode themes: Frisco Historical Tea (Rose)
    - Art in Frisco, Raising Kids in Frisco
    - Uber Athletic in Frisco
    - Wild in Frisco (animal stories)
    - Frisco After Hours
    - The Dumbest Thing I've Done in Frisco
    - Disgruntled in Frisco
    - Lake Life in Frisco (Mark Schneider, )
    - Frisco Food (Bobby Kato, Ryan Worthen, Mama Moose, Johnny Welch, Dan Fallon, Luis, and Dan Kibbie)
    - Love in Frisco (Chief Ryan Cole, Susan Lee, Steve and Alyssa Myatt (Todd contact), Kim Kramer, Chris and Lizzie Johnsen)
